THE PROJECT

€9,000,000 EIIS fundraising to develop a 5.95 MW solar photovoltaic farm to be installed in a 10Ha site at Callatrim South, Bandon, Co Cork. The fundraising is projected to run beyond 2022.

Circa 17500 solar photovoltaic modules each rated at 575W and mounted on rows of 4.0 metre panels.

The solar farm is expected to produce over 8,500 MWh of green renewable electricity per year, exporting it to the local grid network via a 5.95MW export connection to the 20 kV network.
